6C1-4.024 Student Affairs: Summary Disciplinary Hearing.

Notwithstanding anything contained in Rule 6C1-4.023, F.A.C., in the event a student charged with a violation of Rule 6C1-4.016, F.A.C., which, in the opinion of the Director of Student Judicial Affairs, if proven, would not warrant a penalty in excess of two semesters probation, and the student does not waive his or her right to a hearing before the appropriate official or hearing body as provided in Rule 6C1-4.013, F.A.C., the hearing can be held before the Chairperson of the Student Conduct Committee, the Assistant Director of Student Judicial Affairs, or the Director of Student Judicial Affairs rather than before the full Committee. The hearing shall be held in accordance with procedures outlined in the Student Conduct Code, 6C1-4.016(4), F.A.C.
